

## Our Milestones

#### 2020

Hired to shoot a documentary on youth homelessness. Hired summer youth to train and work on the project.

#### 2021

We garnered 800 live viewers for an online art event to support creatives. from different disciplines. Raised 1k for the artists during Covid. Secured our 1st grant for a summer camp.

#### 2022

Trained over 25 students in media arts. Employed over 10 students on film/video projects.

#### 2023

Became the fiscal sponsor and the production team for a social justice project about returning citizens from incarceration.
